Administrative Assistance

- Minimum of 2 hours per week
- Assistance with general office tasks
- Data entry, paperwork, filing
- Must be 18+

Citizenship In-Class Tutor

- Various times and locations
- Meet with students individually or in small groups
- Help adult clients study for the civics exam
- Conduct mock citizenship interviews
- Practice English
- Must be 18+

Childcare in Citizenship Classes

- Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6pm-8pm
- Play with, educate, and supervise children
- Toys, books, and playground on site!
- Must have childcare experience
- Must be 14+

Dare to Care Mobile Food Pantry

- In KRM's parking lot the 3rd Thursday of every month from 11am-1:30pm
- Assist with set-up, check-in, and clean-up
- Must be 18+

Elder Program Tutors

- Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 9:30am-12:30pm
- Help refugee elders learn English, obtain U.S. citizenship, and become active members of their community
- Assist in-class with small groups or individuals
- Must be 16+

English as a Second Language Tutor/Substitute

- Opportunities daily 9:30am-12:30pm and 1:00pm-3:45pm.
- Assist students individually or in small groups
- Practice basic reading, writing, conversation, and job skills
- Lead class if teacher is absent
- Must be fluent in English
- Previous classroom experience preferred
- Must be 18+

Family Center Nursery

- Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 9:30am-12:15pm
- Assist with childcare in the infant, toddler, and preschool classes
- Play with, educate, and supervise
- Must have previous childcare experience
- Must be 14+

Fútbol Friends

- Only 8 Saturdays (starting September 15th)
- Transport KRM youth to and from their Saturday soccer games and stay to cheer them on
- Volunteers can be paired together and assigned one KRM player
- Must have transportation
- Must be 18+

Super Saturdays Client Transportation

- Transport young adult refugees to visit local colleges and universities

Adult Cultural Exchange Program

- One hour per week, you choose when!
- Matched individually with a client
- Orient a client to their new community
- Share culture and practice English
- Must commit to a 4-month mentorship
- Must be 18+

Citizenship Tutor

- One hour per week, you choose when!
- Matched individually with a student
- Help a client study for the citizenship exam, practice English, and conduct mock citizenship interviews
- Volunteer will receive training on the naturalization process
- Must be 18+

Elder Program Mentor

- One hour per week, you choose when!
- Matched individually with a refugee or Cuban elder
- Orient a client to their new community
- Practice English
- Volunteers are welcome to attend monthly community speaker and field trip events
- Must be 18+

Rise-Up Program

- One hour per week, you choose when!
- Matched individually with a young adult (ages 18-25)
- Guide young adult in applying for or succeeding in higher education
- English practice, researching scholarships, choosing a major, etc
- Must be enrolled in or graduated from a higher learning institute
- Must be 18+

Youth Program Mentor

- One hour per week, you choose when!
- Paired with refugee children and youth
- Assist in literacy attainment and homework
- Help establish good study skills
- Orient families to their new community through group discovery field trips
- Must be 16+

Airport Welcome Teams

- On-call, any time and day
- Bring posters, flowers, smiles, and positivity for arrivals at the airport
- Let arriving refugees know we're glad they're here!

Apartment Set-Up/Grocery Shopping

- On-call, any day
- Using the refugee's Reception and Placement funds, purchase groceries (from a list provided by KRM) and put them away
- Straighten up, make beds, put away kitchen supplies, and create a welcoming environment
- Great for small groups or families!

Maintenance Help

- On-call, any day
- Assist with minor repairs and appliance installation in the homes of clients
- Assess if a problem is a quick fix or if KRM should contact the landlord
- Must be 18+

Outreach Team

- On-call, any day. Usually lasts 2-3 hours
- Table a booth for KRM at events, fairs, and festivals
- Volunteers are provided with informational materials with answers to FAQs

Special Events/Fundraisers

- On-call, specific days and times
- Help plan and execute special events throughout the year
 - Global Gourmet, WorldFest, World Refugee Day celebration, etc.
- Must be 16+

Donations Organization

- On-call, any day
- Help sort and organize donations used in resettlement (household items, school supplies, toys, etc.)
- Prepare boxes of donated items needed to furnish a newly arriving refugee family's home
- Ideal for groups
