Representing Clients Applying for Naturalization

Program Description:

"Immigration attorneys from KRM will present a CLE program focused on representing immigrants eligible to apply for U.S. citizenship. The CLE is for attorneys who would like to learn about immigration law and agree to represent at least one KRM client pro bono. The training will cover screening and eligibility for naturalization, requirements to obtain a waiver of the English language and oath requirements, and best practices for working with the local USCIS office.

Upon completion of the CLE, attorneys can volunteer to accept pro bono referrals for citizenship cases from Kentucky Refugee Ministries. Each attorney that accepts a case will be paired with a KRM attorney or BIA accredited representative who can answer questions about the naturalization process.
