KRM Louisville

New Beginnings Tutoring/Mentoring Program:

- 1-2 hours a week, 6 months. You choose when!
- Paired with refugee children and youth
- Assist in literacy attainment and homework
- Help establish good study skills
- Orient families to their new community through group discovery field trips
- Must be 18+
- Or volunteer with a parent/guardian if under 18.

Adult Cultural Exchange:

- 1-2 hours, 3 months. You choose when!
- Matched individually with a client
- Orient a client to their new community
- Share culture and practice English
- Must be 18+

Rise Up Educational Access Program:

- 1.5 hours a week, 6 months. You choose when!
- Matched individually with a young adult (ages 18-25)
- Guide young adult in applying for or succeeding in higher education
- English practice, researching scholarships, choosing a major, etc.
- Must be enrolled in or graduated from a higher learning institute
- Must be 18+

Apartment set-ups:

- On-call, any day
- Using the refugee's Reception and Placement funds, purchase groceries (from a list provided) and put them away
- Straighten, make beds, put away kitchen supplies, and create a welcoming environment
- Great for small groups!

Dare to Care Mobile Food Pantry:

- Occurs in KRM'S parking lot the 3rd Thursday of every month from 11am-4pm
- Assist with making deliveries to KRM clients or loading volunteer cars with food boxes
- Must be 18+ or volunteer with a parent/guardian

Citizenship In-Class Tutor:

- Occurs via Zoom
- Morning, afternoon, or evening availability

Opportunities will be updated as needed for everyone's safety during Covid-19.

- Must be fluent in English
- Must be 18+
